

**Jonathan Willcocks said to me...** I wrote '*Good for you!*' with several aims in mind - to convey important messages about the values of healthy eating and living, to provide groups of young (and not so young) singers with the fun of singing in parts but above all to offer what I hope are attractive and accessible songs which performers and audiences alike will enjoy. I know from my own personal experience that early opportunities to sing and to take part in memorable concerts can lead directly to a lifetime of musical fulfilment and I hope that everyone involved in this '*Good for you!*' performance will have as much fun singing the songs as I did in writing them!

The **Promenade Choirs** were set up by Christopher Goldsack in 2008 to enable him to offer a high quality vocal experience to as many enthusiastic young singers as possible. Christopher has always tried to work closely with local schools and support them in the work they do. This project has been the most obvious manifestation of this. He is grateful to the three participating schools, Ashley School, Bell Farm School and Hurst Park School for joining and supporting him. The project has received generous support from the Charity of Robert Phillips. Many members of the current Youth Choir were members of the Junior Choir whilst at these schools and have stayed with Promenade as they moved into secondary schools.

The Junior Choir (ages 8-12) rehearses on a Monday evening from 6.30 to 7.45 at Bell Farm School, and the Youth Choir (ages 12+) from 7.45 to 9. Both choirs are non-auditioned and welcome every singer who is prepared to work hard! They are funded by subscription but bursaries are available. He also runs a Girls' Choir which is strictly auditioned. With a thought to the future, anyone interested in joining forces with existing members of the Ladies Choir to create a mixed voice chamber choir should let Christopher know.

#### Dates for the diary:

The next rehearsals for the Youth and Junior Choirs will be Monday 31<sup>st</sup> October. There will be a Christmas workshop for the Girls' Choir with a Christmas concert on 21<sup>st</sup> or 22<sup>nd</sup> December. The Youth Choir will be working towards a performance of Handel's Messiah involving several local secondary schools, with the support of the R.C.Sherriff Trust. That will be on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> March, probably in Christ the Prince of Peace Church, Weybridge.



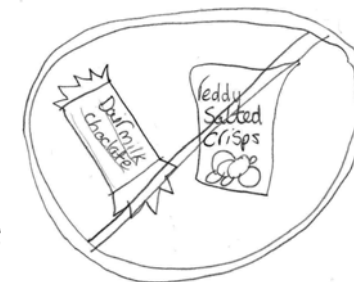

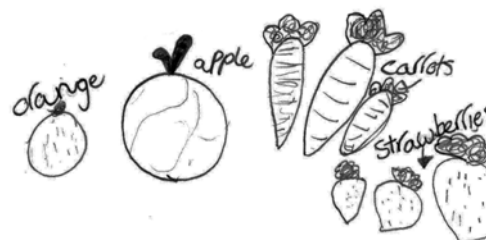

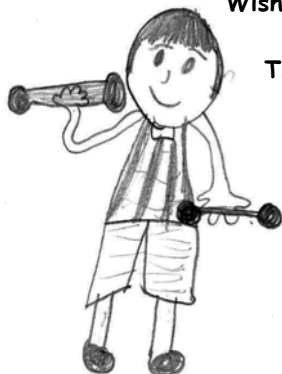
